

## **Information for Sales People at Artisans on fifth Featured Artist: Joyce Eaton Brady**

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### Materials and Techniques:

- Jewelry pieces are embellished with beads, featuring semi-precious stones, crystals, pearls, art glass and pewter. Other decorative adornments may include shells, metal pieces, silver/gold/copper leaf, ceramic pieces and terracotta tiles to form unique necklaces and coordinating earrings.
- Jewelry findings include sterling silver, gold filled, brass and copper. Various clasps are used including magnetic, toggle, box and tube clasps.
- Bead weaving – Employs many different bead stitches and is done using seed beads of varying sizes.
- Bead embroidery – Beads are sewn onto a material backing. When the beaded design is completed, leather ultra-suede is applied to the back of the jewelry piece and the piece is sewn together and trimmed with beads.
